#### **GENDER AUDIT: AN INTRODUCTION**

#### A. What is Gender Audit?

Gender Audit is a tool to assess gender balance and gender equality in an institution. It includes safe and secure ambience for all students, faculty, and administrative staff in an institution. It keeps a check on policies of the government, rules if they are followed to maintain gender equality. It also makes sure that the institution takes efforts to maintain gender equality. The participatory audit in events, activities, programmes of the institution help in analysing and evaluating gender equity. The two dimensions of Gender Audit could be:

#### (1) An Internal Audit

According to European Institute for Gender Equality, "This dimension refers to how much an organisation fosters gender equality internally within its organisational, managerial structure and internal work, and whether these contribute to gender equality in the organisation. An internal gender audit monitors and assesses the relative progress made in gender mainstreaming, contributes to capacity building and collective organisational ownership for gender equality initiatives, and sharpens organisational learning on gender".

#### (2) An External Audit

According to European Institute for Gender Equality, "This dimension aims to assess to what extent an organisation mainstreams gender in its policies, programmes, projects and services in terms of content, delivery and evaluation. External gender audits evaluate to what extent gender integration fosters the inclusion of, and benefits to, women and men involved in or





#### **GENDER SENSITIZATION INITIATIVES**

#### A. Gender balance within the institution

The college does not have any power to appoint staff in the college except the ones through Janbhagidari Committee but there is no reservation of women in it according to the rules of the government. It is through MP Higher Education that the teaching staff (Permanent and Guest Faculty) and Class III and IV (Permanent) employees are appointed. The number of seats for the students are also allocated by MP Higher Education. The ratio of male:female is increasing with time. The institution makes sure that more and more female students are motivated to go for higher education. The Gender Audit Team reviewed and analysed that each one has access to resources and opportunities to physical, social, and psychological benefits by getting to participate in sports activities. The NCC unit is also seeing the involvement of women from the year 2021 after 33 percent of reservation of women thus imbibing in them qualities of comradeship, discipline, leadership, secularism, and spirit of adventure. Seminar, lectures and a workshop have been organised relating to eating the right way, self-defense, laws for women. Policies like Anti-Ragging Policy, Gender Sensitization and Equity Policy and Anti-Sexual Harassment Policy have been implemented for women and men in the institution.







#### B. Gender Sensitization Initiatives

- During examinations, boys and girls have separate entrances to avoid any rush and for the safety of women.
- There is a Girls Common Room with an attached washroom.
- There are separate washrooms for women and men and hygiene is maintained regularly.
- There is a sanitary napkin vending machine in the Girls Common Room and incinerator.
- There are 79 CCTV cameras in the college to ensure safety and security of students and staff. 37 CCTV cameras are there in the main building, 16 in Block A, 16 in Bock B and 10 on the first floor of Block A.

## The following Policies and Committees and participation have helped in attaining Gender Sensitization:

• There is a policy of POSH in the college in accordance with POSH Act 2013 which elaborates on how to file a complaint against sexual harassment and an Anti-Sexual Harassment Cell and policy.







#### A. Conclusion
